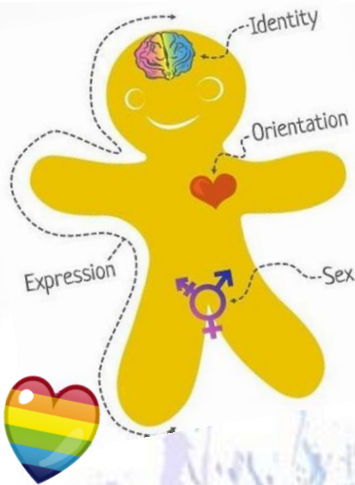
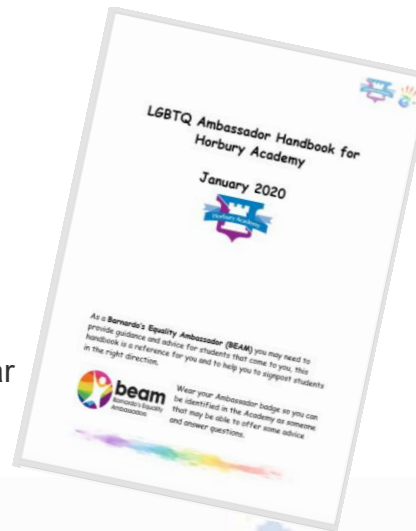
What is LGBTQ?
